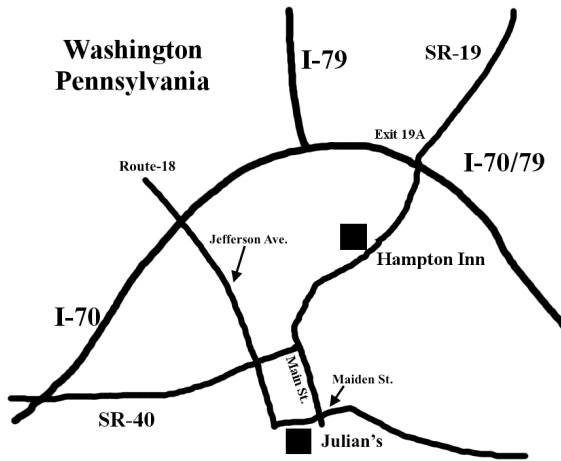

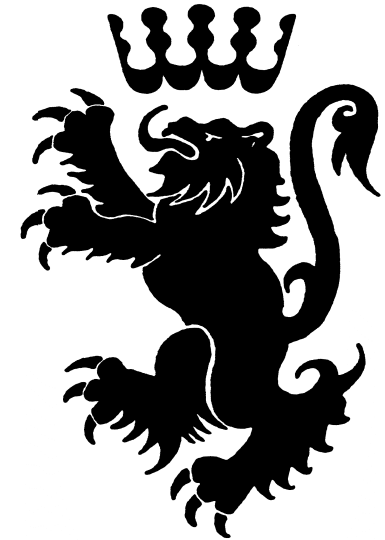
## Washington, PA
