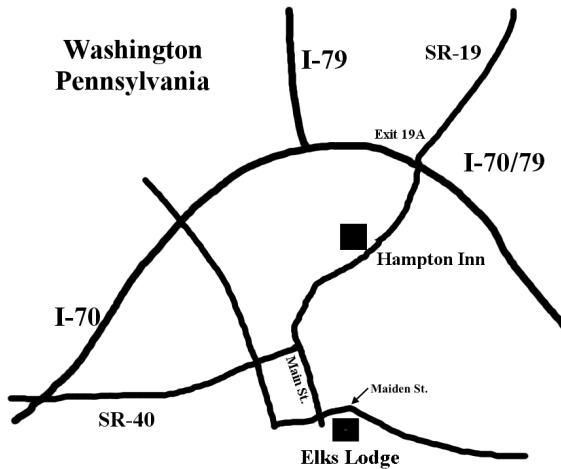


Highland Square

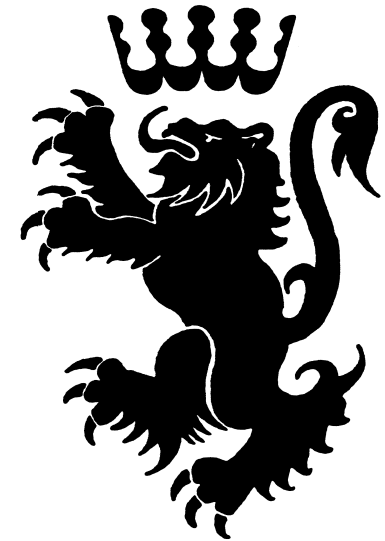
Washington, PA
